## One man hospitalized, another in custody following EMR shooting

One man remains hospitalized in serious, but stable condition while another is in police custody following a shooting incident in Pinedale, Eight Mile Rock New Year's Day.

According to police press officer, Assistant Superintendent of Police (ASP) Terecita Pinder, Public Affairs and Communication Officer (PACO) police were called to the scene shortly before 10:00 p.m.

Tuesday, January 1.

Police information revealed that officers responded to gunshots being heard in the Pinedale. On arrival officers met a male with gunshot wounds to the upper body.

As a result of their initial investigations, police learned that two men were involved in an altercation when one of the males shot the other to the upper body, before fleeing the scene.


Emergency medical personnel, who were dispatched attended to the victim at the scene before transporting him to the trauma center. (Continued on Page 3)


